HOW TO OPERATE:

- 1. LOOSEN KNOB AND ROTATE AND MOVE OUTWARD TO EXPOSE PROBES.
- 2. FOR CARPET, PAD, AND UPHOLSTERY, THE POINTS CAN BE INSERTED INTO THE MATERIAL.
- 3. FOR WOOD, PLASTER, AND DRYWALL, JUST TOUCH THE POINTS TO THE MATERIAL SURFACE.
- 4. WHEN BOTH POINTS CONTACT MOIST MATERIALS, THE SENSOR BEGINS TO BEEP AND THIS USUALLY INDICATES ABNORMAL MOISTURE.
- 5. A FASTER BEEP INDICATES GREATER MOISTURE CONDITION AND A SLOWER BEEP INDICATES LESS MOISTURE. IN BOTH CASES, DRYING SHOULD CONTINUE UNTIL NO BEEP OCCURS.
- $6.\ \text{NOTE:}$ FALSE READINGS MAY OCCUR DUR TO CONDUCTIVITY FROM SOURCES SUCH AS METAL OR URINE SALTS.
