WALLPAPER STEAMER INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove steam plate and lay in a pan to hold condensed steam. Cookie sheets work well. Don't put in porcelain sink or tub; the steam can cause it to break.
- 2. Remove cap and fill 2 inches from the top. Don't overfill or it will overflow from vent tube.
- 3. Plug directly into outlet. It will take 10 to 30 minutes to create steam depending on how hot the water was you put in it. The steam will eventually come out of the plate.
- 4. Start at the top of the wall and work across and down. Hold plate against paper for 15 to 60 seconds depending on the type of paper. Move the plate and overlap the area you just steamed. With a broad flat putty knife, scrape the paper from the wall being careful not to gouge the wallboard.
- 5. Steam is going to condense and run down the wall so have your floor covered and towels handy.
- 6. When the tank runs out of water, unplug the machine and wait a few minutes for it to cool off. The cap will be hot so use a rag or hot pad to remove. Refill and keep on steaming.

BE CAREFUL! THE HOSE IS HOT AND STEAM CAN BURN YOU VERY QUICKLY!
